



**Agreement to Defer Admission to the LLM/LLCM Program
from the Class of 2020-2021 to the Class of 2021-2022**

I have been offered admission to the Penn Law **LLM/LLCM Class of 2020-2021** and, after making my Initial and/or Second Summer Program Deposit, have requested that the Law School defer my admission to permit me to enter with the **LLM Class of 2021-2022** instead. Acknowledging that financial assistance awards (if any) cannot be carried over from one year to another, I hereby agree to deferral, if granted, under the following terms:

Credit for Deposit: I have separately submitted a deposit payment of at least \$500 (or will do so within seven days of being granted a deferral.) I understand that, while this deposit is otherwise non-refundable, the Law School will credit it to my Summer Program fee upon my matriculation at Penn Law.

Next Steps: I understand that, no later than January 15 of the calendar when I plan to matriculate at Penn Law, I must:

- email the Office of Graduate Programs at gradhelp@law.upenn.edu of my intent to matriculate later that same year as described above; and
- make a further deposit of \$2,250 (or, if less, the equivalent of \$2,750 less the total amount of any related deposits that I may have already made to Penn Law.)

Restrictions: I affirm that, while holding deferred status at Penn Law, I will neither:

- hold deferred status at any other law school;
- enroll in any graduate law program; nor
- apply for admission to a graduate program at any other law school.

Timely Notice and Compliance: I understand that, in addition to any other action it may deem appropriate, Penn Law may withdraw my admission if I fail to provide timely notification and payment, or to comply with restrictions, as described in this agreement. I further understand that the entire \$2,750 Summer Program Deposit is non-refundable.
