

Theodore I. Koskoff Trial Advocacy Fellowship

One of the greatest trial lawyers of his generation, Theodore I. Koskoff, was renowned for his eloquence, his brilliant trial tactics, and his supreme mastery of the powers of persuasion. He founded the law firm of Koskoff, Koskoff, & Bieder in 1936 and dedicated himself to the representation of individuals harmed by the abuse of corporate and governmental power. Although he was involved in some of the highest profile cases of his day, he preferred to represent ordinary individuals struggling against an unjust establishment. Building on Ted's legacy, the Koskoff firm continues as one of the nation's premier trial law firms, recently celebrating its 75th year. The firm obtains substantial verdicts for its clients and enjoys a national reputation in the areas of medical malpractice and personal injury law. The firm uses its substantial resources to pursue important civil rights and impact litigation.

The TIK fellow will work at the Koskoff firm on cases involving wrongful death and other serious tort cases, as well as equal rights, individual liberty and access to justice. The focus of the fellowship is on learning the art of trial advocacy and the fellow will work closely with exceptional trial lawyers. The fellow must be willing to participate in the presentation of evidence at trial, and the firm will strive to provide opportunities for meaningful trial experience. The fellow will have a demonstrated commitment to the rights of individuals, have superior academic credentials and be admitted to the Connecticut Bar (or plan to sit for the exam immediately upon graduation).

Duration of Fellowship: September 2020 through September 2021.
