Patent law has become crucial for engineers, doctors, entrepreneurs, and other professionals who interact with or seek familiarity with the patent system. This online course takes a broad look at U.S. patent law, from the enforcement of patents to the interpretation of patent claims. With online drop-in office hours and Q&A discussions, students will be able to gain an understanding of the policy principles underlying the U.S. patent system; analyze patent documents and obtain skill sets to work with patent representatives; learn about the process of obtaining a valid patent for an invention or technology; work with entrepreneurs to enforce patents — or avoid infringing them; and manage damages in cases where patents are violated.
