Seeking Temporary Summer 2022 Attorney Assistance

The Gittis Legal Clinics of the University of Pennsylvania Carey Law School invites applications from Pennsylvania-licensed attorneys to provide temporary, part-time, legal assistance under faculty supervision during the summer months of June, July, and August (approximately 75 days) on several pending cases on behalf of indigent clients in civil matters. The attorney must be licensed to practice law in Pennsylvania, be in good standing, and have experience or familiarity with handling civil matters, especially social security disability, housing, consumer, guardianship, and probate.

The position is to assist faculty in the [Civil Practice Clinic](#), which is Penn Law's oldest in-house clinic serving the community. The Civil Practice Clinic enjoys a long and distinguished history of providing high quality legal assistance to indigent clients in a broad range of civil litigation matters.
