Fellowship Overview

Eligible Candidates

While PEF is intended for the last summer of a candidate's joint-degree program, exceptions will be made for candidates willing to commit to two consecutive summer associateships with Kirkland, one of which may be spent seconded to a Kirkland private equity client.

Signing Bonus and MBA Tuition Defrayment Stipend

In addition to a \$25,000 JD/MBA signing bonus, Fellows will receive \$50,000 to help defray their MBA tuition costs. The signing bonus and stipend will be paid after Fellows have become full-time associates at the Firm.
