- Events with alcohol must have an educational component
- Student groups must have a bartender in attendance at any event with alcohol. You may secure a bartender through your cater, or you may hire a University bartender by following the instructions below:

- I. Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Law Prohibits:
 - a. The selling or furnishing of alcoholic beverages to persons under the age of 21. "Furnish" means to supply, give or provide to, or to allow to possess on premises;
 - b. The consumption of alcoholic beverages by persons under the age of 21;
 - c. Direct or indirect sale of alcoholic beverages without a license.
- II. The University of Pennsylvania Policy on Use of Alcohol requires the following:
 - a. University funds may not be used to purchase alcoholic beverages that will be served to persons under the legal drinking age;
 - b. Individuals or groups sponsoring University events will take reasonable measures to ensure that alcohol is not sold, served, or made available to persons who are under the legal drinking age, or to persons who are obviously inebriated;
 - c. Publicity for University social events directed primarily toward students will not include advertising the availability of alcohol at these events;
 - d. Persons in charge of various University facilities should, in consultation with students and others, develop and implement guidelines consistent with University policy for the use of alcoholic beverages in their facilities;
 - e. While the University recognizes that alcohol plays a role in some social activities, it deplores its misuse and abuse. Alcohol consumption will not be considered an excuse for misconduct, but rather an aggravating factor to the misconduct in question;
 - f. Alcohol may not leave the area of the event and under no circumstances be taken outside the building.
