CTIC Summer Public Interest Fellowship

Each year, CTIC's Public Interest Fellowship program funds internships with public interest or government organizations doing work relevant to CTIC's focus on technology policy, intellectual property, cyber law, privacy, and related fields. This fellowship is open to Penn Law 1Ls and 2Ls, and recipients can receive up to \$5,500.

The CTIC Public Interest Fellowship Application period for summer 2019 is now open and will close on March 1, 2019. Summer funding notifications will be made soon thereafter.

How to Apply: Through [Symlicity](#), click on “Jobs” then search for key word #23518. Upload your resume and a cover letter addressed “Dear Selection Committee” that describe the kind of work you anticipate doing this summer, the kind of work you hope to do following graduation, and how this fellowship would relate to that work. Your cover letter must be saved and uploaded as “Cover Letter – CTIC”.

Please be sure to complete the [Summer Funding Changes](#) survey if your employment plans change or you secure funding from outside sources.

We strongly encourage you to wait until you have secured summer employment before applying for funding, as certain funding sources give preference to applicants who have confirmed their summer plans. If you have not secured summer plans by March 1, please complete your application and apply to all sources of funding for which you believe you may be eligible.
