

Mr. Ian Fishback, University of Michigan, Department of Philosophy

Ian Fishback is an interdisciplinary scholar of rule of law. His current work explores the moral foundations of obedience to orders and command responsibility in unconventional warfare contexts. During over a decade of service as a US Special Forces officer, Ian disobeyed illegal orders and challenged illegal conduct on numerous occasions including a stand against former President Bush's torture policy, training that prescribed illegal conduct in the Special Forces Qualification Course, and detachments with cultures of abusing civilians. He earned his B.S. at West Point in Middle Eastern Studies, M.A.s at the University of Michigan in philosophy and political science, and is currently completing a PhD at the University of Michigan. He's taught at West Point and the Naval Postgraduate School. He served in the 82nd Airborne Division and 5th Special Forces Group.
