Mr. Rutigliano is the Branch Head, for the International and Operational Law Branch, Judge Advocate Division, Headquarters, U.S. Marine Corps. He also serves as the Special Assistant on Law of War Matters. He has been with the Branch since July 1998. His responsibilities include providing advice on law of war issues, international agreements/treaties, counterdrug operations, rules of engagement, rules for the use of force, intelligence law, cyber law, and other areas of international and domestic law impacting military exercises, training, and operations.

Mr. Rutigliano is a former Marine judge advocate and a veteran of Operations Desert Shield and Desert Storm.
