Lieutenant Anderson is currently serving as Naval Special Warfare Group ONE Staff Judge Advocate. She earned a bachelor of arts degree in criminal justice and psychology at the University of Maryland, College Park. After college, LT Anderson worked as both a local and federal police officer in Maryland. While working full-time, she received a master of science degree in criminal justice from Boston University Metropolitan College and graduated with a business law concentration from the University of Baltimore (UB) School of Law. While in law school, LT Anderson was a law scholar, a research assistant, and a Maryland State Bar Association – UB Business Law Clerkship Fellow. LT Anderson is admitted to practice law in Maryland and Florida. She commissioned as an Ensign in August 2011 through the JAG Corps Student Program.

LT Anderson's first tour included time as a defense attorney, legal assistance attorney and trial attorney with Region Legal Service Office Southeast and Naval Legal Service Office Southeast at Naval Air Station Jacksonville and Naval Station Mayport in Jacksonville, Florida. LT Anderson spent her second tour as the Command Judge Advocate and Ethics Counselor at Naval Hospital Bremerton, Washington. Lieutenant Anderson then went on to serve as Deputy Assistant Force/Fleet Judge Advocate for Commander, U.S. Naval Forces Central Command/FIFTH Fleet/Combined Maritime Forces. She also served as Flag Aide to the Deputy Judge Advocate General and Commander, Naval Legal Service Command.

LT Anderson's military decorations consist of the Navy Achievement Medal and the Navy Commendation Medal (three awards).
